FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF OTHERS, PLEASE BE ADVISED



FOG & LIGHTNING: In the event of an electrical storm, suspend play immediately & take appropriate action.

DO NOT continue to play in fog or poor visibility, when you cannot see the clear distance of your intended shot.



GREENS STAFF: HAVE PRIORITY ON THE COURSE AT ALL TIMES.

Players should always alert staff nearby or ahead when they are about to make a stroke that might endanger them and wait for them to move out of range.



THE COURSE, STEPS & STEEP SURFACES: May be slippery when wet or damp.

Golfers must wear the appropriate footwear to meet the prevailing conditions. Where possible, keep to covered footpaths & steps. Always take care on steep banks & when entering/exiting bunkers.



BUGGIES: To ensure the safety of all buggy users, buggy drivers are required to comply with the Club's Buggy Policy. Take particular care on slopes, around ditches and deep sided bunkers.



BLIND SHOTS: Several holes on the course have blind shots. It is the player's responsibility to ensure the way ahead is clear before playing.

- Players must be certain that there is no one in front within range before playing a shot.
- Players must ensure that no one is standing nearby or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball, any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when making a stroke or practice swing.
- If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, they must immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such situations is 'FORE!'.
- On hearing 'FORE!' – crouch and cover your head with your arms and count to 10.
